

Creating a Hi-Res PDF from Photoshop® for Print



Resolution and Color

(1) When creating materials for print within Photoshop, it must first be created at **300** pixels per inch and in **CMYK** color mode to get the best print quality from your Photoshop file. Any file created with less than 300 pixels per inch will print blurry or pixelated. **Changing the resolution of a file that has already been created with less than 300 pixels per inch will not help the quality.**

Saving your file as a Hi-Res PDF

- **(2)** Go to File pull down menu and select **"Save As..."**
- **(3)** With the Save As window open, name and select a location for your PDF such as your desktop. Next choose **"Photoshop PDF"** next to Format. Uncheck **"Layers"** then click **"Save"**. You're done!
